Parents & Friends of St John the Baptist School, Waltham Chase	Refurbishment at the school of wooden climbing frame and grounds improvements including new benches to expand available outdoor space and make it more usable.	£2,000
Hands Up Foundation (UK working in Lebanon charity)	UK registered charity set up by 4 British friends providing primary education for 300 Syrian refugees in Bekaa Valley Lebanon. Charity is assisting with more than one million Syrian refugees in Lebanon.	£2,313
Motiv8 South Gosport, Havant, Portsmouth	Create quality, long-term support for 9-19 year olds. Help them move forward positively & make sustained change. Most referred by schools or police as 'at risk'. 10 people and their families.	£2,000
Centre for Community Developmental Restoration (Cameroonian charity)	Project to provide energy via solar panels in village health centre, including maternity ward. Currently no access to electricity or a generator.	£2,500
Education for Sustainable & Rural Development Foundation (Cameroonian charity)	To build a 4-unit disabled access pit toilet with hand washing facilities at community school with over 280 pupils. Currently has no toilets. Suffered cholera epidemic in 2019.	£1,675
Community Alliance for Women Advancement (Tanzanian charity)	Training programme for orphans in tailoring & embroidery, welding & metal fabrication, motor repairs, carpentry, and computer skills.	£2,364
Sacred Society for Agricultural Cultural & Rural Education Development (Indian charity)	Revolving income generating project focussing on apiary. 20 widows supported initially to generate income from honey and other bee products.	£1,938
